


3. All insurance benefits delivered or issued for delivery in this state as part of a credit card transaction and without additional charge shall comply in full with all applicable provisions of Vermont law and regulation;
4. The Commissioner may exercise all investigatory and enforcement powers set forth in Title 8 V.S.A., including, but not limited to, the market conduct examination provisions of Subchapter 7 of Chapter 101, to ensure that the issuers of credit card-related insurance benefits comply with their obligations under Vermont law;
5. This Order may be rescinded in whole or in part if the Commissioner determines that the filing and approval of such benefits is necessary for the protection of Vermont consumers.
