

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


Vermont COVID-19 New Case Rates Per 100K (14-Day Average)


Vermont COVID-19 Hospitalizations

New Daily Hospital Admissions Per 100K (14-Day Average)





National COVID-19 Case Rates Per 100K Last 7 Days





COVID-19 Testing Per 100K Last 7 Days





Vermont Test Positivity: Delta Wave






Active Cases in Vermont Counties






Estimated vs Detected COVID-19 Cases in Vermont

Median age of COVID positive individuals in VT over the last 14 days.





VT COVID-19 Infections per 100K by Age Group










Vermont Case Rate By Age (7-Day Average)



Vermont Covid-19 Case Rates by Age (7-Day Average)






Active COVID Cases per Million in Vermont Regions




Comparing Vermont 7 Most & 7 Least Vaccinated Counties Over Last 30 Days





Vermont Higher Education Cases By Semester






Statewide Covid-19 Critical Care Usage




Weekly Covid-19 Deaths In Vermont














Vermonters Initiating Vaccination By Day



By Age Band






Infections, Hospitalizations, & Deaths by Percentage of State Population Vaccinated










Percent of All Hospital Beds Used for COVID-19



Data Point 1: Syndromic Surveillance


- **Summary:** Percentage of visits with COVID-19 like illness and Influenza diagnosis
- Warning Flag: Percentage of visits exceeding 4% for multiple consecutive days

Vermont Department of Health no longer updating syndromic surveillance on a weekly basis.


